Pasar Malam Traders to be Evicted?

Mon, 10 Sept - In a shocking turn of events, traders at the Kg Kerinchi pasar malam were told last week that they must vacate the pasar malam location they have been at for the past 20 years. YB Nurul Izzah intervened in the nick of time when, on Friday 7th September at 5pm, DBKL came down to evict the traders even as visitors arrived for the bi-weekly pasar malam. She managed to negotiate with DBKL to delay the eviction until certain key issues have been cleared, including:

- providing a suitable replacement site for the pasar malam
- traffic impact assessment report, as DBKL said the road is to be dedicated for the nearby development site
- environmental impact assessment report

Subsequently, YB Nurul Izzah organized a press conference on Monday 10th September with the traders to highlight their plight.
