Even so, most MPs did not receive any advanced copy of the budget document, which made it very difficult to do preliminary research and preparations prior to the meeting. YB Nurul Izzah took time out of the busy Parliamentary schedule to attend this session, and voiced some of the concerns raised by residents in Lembah Pantai including related to how the budget is used to deal with persistent problems like rubbish and potholes.

It is hoped that DBKL will in future release detailed documents relating to its annual budget early so that the concerned public may peruse and provide some talking points to representatives attending such briefings.

Debating Budget 2013



Thurs, 4 Oct - YB Nurul Izzah today called the 2013 Budget a

budget by a Najib administration that has both financial deficit as well as moral deficit. Her 30-minute speech in the August Dewan Rakyat today brought forward many issues, many of which are shared by constituents in Lembah Pantai, including:

- Budget 2013 fails to ensure the future of the youth
- the youth can no longer afford to own their own homes - on average it costs us 15x our annual salaries to buy a house, while the international average is 5x
- the youth are called to "honour their debts", while the debts of political cronies are often forgiven
- one-off "goodies" like the RM200 smartphone rebate and BR1M 2.0 fails in comparison to Pakatan Rakyat's assurance of systematically increasing the people's disposable income
